Sat 7/1/17 Depart USA

Sun 7/2/17 Arrive Ulaanbataar, Mongolia

Arrive in Ulaanbataar, Mongolia's capital. Free time to explore on your own if you have the energy. Stay in Ulaanbataar for 2 nights.

Mon 7/3/17 Ulaanbataar

Enjoy a city tour of Ulaanbataar with professional guide and private transport: Gandan Buddhist Monastery, Winter Palace of the last Mongol king, National History Museum, Genghis Khan Square, and Zaisan hill for a panoramic view of the city. In the evening attend a Mongolian cultural show with 15 different performances, including traditional songs, dancing, throat singing, and contortionists. Night #2 in Ulaanbataar.

<u>7/4/</u>17 <u>Ulaanbataar - Gobi Desert</u>

One-hour flight to the Gobi Desert, then drive 2-3 hours to the Flaming Cliffs, a world renowned archaeological site for the numerous dinosaur bones and eggs found there. Made of red sandstone, these cliffs are especially beautiful in the late afternoon. Visit a local family. Overnight in a ger (yurt) camp, with all meals included. Gers are comfortable with beds and a separate building for hot showers and sit-down toilets.

7/5/17 Gobi Desert

Drive to Khongor Sand Dunes, the most magnificent dunes of the Gobi. They are "singing dunes", humming when the sand is moved by the wind or by footsteps. Climb the dunes if you are energetic, or take an optional camel ride. Overnight in a ger camp, with all meals included.

7/6/17 Gobi Desert

Drive to Yolyn Am, a narrow canyon where the shade keeps some places covered by thick ice year-round. Hike about 2 hours between the tall cliffs. Visit a nature museum with dinosaul eggs and pones, along with a stuffed snow leopard. Overnight in a ger camp, with all meals included.

7/7/17 Gobi Desert- Tereli National Park Fri

Morning flight from the Gobi Desert to Ulaanbataar. Drive about one hour to Terelj National Park, located at 5000' with beautiful alpine scenery. Optional activities include walking, hiking, and horseback riding. Overnight in a ger camp, with all meals included.

Terelj National Park - Ulaanbataar

Morning free for optional activities in Terelj – hiking, horseback riding, or whitewater rafting. Visit giant Genghis Khan Statue en route to Ulaanbataar. One night in Ulaanbataar in a hotel, with breakfast included.

Sun 7/9/17 Ulaanbataar – Lake Khovsgol

Morning flight from Ulaanbataar to Murun in northern Mongolia. Visit beautiful Lake Khövsgöl, the second largest freshwater lake in Asia. This lake holds about 70% of Mongolia's fresh water, and is a smaller version of Lake Baikal of Siberia, a short distance to the north. The lake is surrounded by mountains, thick forest, and lush meadows. Overnight in a ger camp, with all meals included.

7/10/17 Lake Khovsgol

Explore the lake by boating and hiking. Possibly see nomadic reindeer herders. Overnight in a ger camp, with all meals included.

7/11/17 Naadam Festival

Naadam is Mongolia's famous annual festival, coinciding with Mongolian Independence Day. There is a parade, colorfully dressed singers and dancers, archery, wrestling, and more. These festivities are celebrated throughout Mongolia; we will attend Naadam at one of the towns near Lake Khuvsgul such as Khatgal or Murun. Ger camp or hotel, with all meals included.

7/12/17 Naadam Festival (Day 2) – Ulaanbataar




7/13/17 Depart Mongolia
