

Sun 2/18/18 – Depart USA for Bangkok, Thailand

Mon 2/19/18 – In flight to Bangkok

Tue 2/20/18 – Arrival in Bangkok

Arrive Bangkok and spend one night in Bangkok (hotel and taxi costs not included)

Wed 2/21/18 - Arrive Bhutan

Fly Bangkok to Paro, Bhutan

This ticket can only be purchased by Bhutan agency that GeoTours is working with Arrive in Bhutan in the afternoon

Visit impressive Paro Dzong (castle/fortress), part of which is a Buddhist monastery Take a stroll from the fortress to an old covered, wooden bridge over the Paro River Drive through the mountains1.5 hours to Thimphu, Bhutan's capital city Two nights in Thimphu at Namgay Heritage Hotel

Beautifully designed in traditional Bhutanese style

<u>Thu 2/22/18 - Thimphu</u>

Full day in Thimphu, Bhutan's largest city Visit excellent Simply Bhutan Museum that showcases the culture of Bhutan Postal Museum, where Bhutan's unique stamps and postal history are on display See Bhutan's native wildlife at an animal preserve, including the unusual "takin" Thimphu Dzong (fortress), still used for many of Bhutan's national government offices Night #2 in Thimphu

Fri 2/23/18 – Thimphu to Punakha

Drive through the Himalayas with great views of the Himalayan peaks

Stop at Dochula Pass (10, 200'), with 108 memorial chortens Descend to Punakha Valley (4200')

Walk through villages and farmland to Chimi Lakhang Temple Can receive a unique blessing from the Buddhist monks Hike through farmland and forest to colorful Khamsum YuelleyTemple 3 nights in Punakha at Meri Puensem Resort

Sat 2/24/18 – Punakha Drubchen (Festival)

Watch colorful dances inside the very impressive Punakha Dzong (fortress) Night #2 in Punakha


Sun 2/25/18 – Punakha Tsechu (Festival)

Enjoy a colorful festival in Punakha with elaborate masked dances Most of the audience are locals dressed in their finest clothes Festival takes place in spectacular Punkaha Dzong (castle) Night #3 in Punakha















Mon 2/26/18 – Punkaha to Paro

Drive through the Himalayas to Paro Marvel at snow-capped Himalayan peaks from the ruins of Drukgyel Dzong Souvenir shopping in Paro (reasonable prices) Two nights in Paro at Metta Resort

Tue 2/27/18 - Paro

Hike through forested mountains to cliff-hanging Tiger's Nest Monastery Last-minute shopping for souvenirs in Paro Night #2 in Paro at Metta Resort

Wed 2/28/18 - Depart Bhutan

Depart Bhutan to Bangkok, Thailand One night in Bangkok (extra cost); most flights to the USA depart in the morning

Thu 3/1/18 – Depart Bangkok to USA

Fly home to the USA, or spend more time traveling in Asia on your own Probably arrive home same day you depart, March 1

GeoTours Bhutan Details:

- 1) **Dates**:
 - a) Depart Sunday, February 18, 2018 from USA to Bangkok, Thailand, connecting on Druk Air to Bhutan on February 21, 2018.
 - b) Return to USA on Thursday, March 1, 2018 from Bangkok, or continue traveling on your own in Thailand or elsewhere.
- 2. $\underline{Cost} = \frac{\$2090}{\$2090}$ (without airfare) for 8 days/7 nights in Bhutan (this is a good price for a Bhutan tour)
 - a) Includes lodging, entries, activities, transport in a private bus, English-speaking guide, driver, 3 meals a day, tea/coffee/bottled water, Suzan Ebiner as group leader.
 - b) Extra costs in Bhutan: visa (**\$40, easily arranged by GeoTours**), soft drinks, alcohol, tips, souvenirs, laundry
 - c) Airfare from Bangkok-Bhutan-Bangkok costs <u>\$650</u> and must be purchased through the Bhutan agency GeoTours works with (payment to GeoTours)
 - d) Airfare LAX-BKK -LAX for February, 2018 will cost about **\$700-800** round-trip (fares will be announced by airlines by April 1, 2017)
 - e) Overnight in Bangkok on February 20 is necessary in order to catch morning flight on February 21 from Bangkok to Bhutan. Bangkok hotel and taxi costs are extra. GeoTours will give Bangkok travel recommendations.
 - f) Overnight in Bangkok on February 28 is also necessary since the flight from Bhutan to Bangkok arrives in the late afternoon. Bangkok hotel and taxi costs are extra. GeoTours will give Bangkok travel recommendations.
- 3. <u>Group size = 16 maximum (+ Bhutanese crew of driver and 2 guides)</u>
- 4. Hotels = 3 and 4-star properties, all with free wi-fi, private bathrooms, hot water, very kind/helpful staff
 - a) Namgay Heritage Hotel, Thimphu
 - b) Meri Puensem Resort, Punakha
 - c) Metta Resort, Paro

Why Bhutan is considered such an OUTSTANDING off-the-beaten-track travel destination:

- A remote Himalayan kingdom that is one of the least visited countries of Asia (7000 US tourists to Bhutan per year)
- Traditional culture is seen everywhere in Bhutan, from the beautiful clothing to the distinctive architecture
- Pursues Gross National Happiness as its primary goal
- Environmental conservation about 70% of Bhutan is covered by forest
- Friendly, gentle people with a high level of customer service
- Last country in the world to get TV (1999), but now has strong, free Wi-Fi access at hotels and restaurants
- In Bhutan there are no billboards, not a single traffic light, no fast food restaurants, no shopping malls, no plastic bags, no large-scale commercialism or commercialization
- No large-scale tourism, partly since it is an expensive destination (fixed rate of \$250/ person /day to tour Bhutan)
- Few travelers in Bhutan in February, which increases the mystique of the places we visit
- Excellent guide will be with us daily to help us learn about Bhutan and answer any questions
- Brand new, heated bus and a safe, experienced driver will ensure a comfortable trip
- GeoTours has partnered with an excellent Bhutanese agency, which makes all of our tour arrangements

Important Information to Know about the GeoTours Bhutan tour:

- GeoTours trips emphasize cultural, natural, and historical places, with off-the-beaten track experiences, too.
- Participants on this GeoTours trip should enjoy active travel and should be able to walk up to 2 or 3 miles a day
- Bhutan is in the Himalayas and the tour visits places from 4,000'-10,000' elevation, so the amount of oxygen is reduced
- Hotels sometimes do not have elevators and rooms are sometimes on the 2^{nd} or 3^{rd} floor
- Roads in Bhutan are often winding or bumpy
- The weather in February will be cold at night and in the morning (30-40F), but will warm up to around 45-65F in the daytime. It is usually sunny and dry. It is important to bring warm clothing. A list of things to bring will be provided by GeoTours.
