Georgia, Armenia, and Azerbaijan share the Caucasus Mountains, a towering, glaciated mountain range separating Europe from Asia. This is a region of natural beauty, cosmopolitan cities, charming small towns, rich history, a fascinating diversity of culture, and excellent food. This tour will visit the highlights of these countries, including all 3 capital cities, several UNESCO World Heritage sites, spectacular mountains, and many historical sites. The group will be ~20 people.

TOUR COST = \$2690

Includes lodging in a double/twin room, breakfasts, 2 dinners, private transport, professional English-speaking guide in each country, Matt and/or Suzan Ebiner as group leaders, and entries/activities. Single room costs +\$800. Optional Georgia hiking extension costs +\$1290.

NOT INCLUDED

Airfare from the USA (about \$1800 round-trip from LAX to Baku; Yerevan to LAX), meals not listed above, drinks, tips to drivers and guides, shopping. Participants can spend additional time traveling on their own before or after the tour.

Sunday - 6/9/24 – Depart USA

Monday - 6/10/24 - Arrive Baku, Azerbaijan

Arrive in Baku, Azerbaijan's capital. Stay in Baku for 3 nights at Shaha Palace or equivalent.

Tuesday - 6/11/24 - Baku, Azerbaijan

Take a guided tour of Baku to see the historical and architectural highlights. Visit Memory Alley with a great panoramic view of the city. Explore the new part of the city with innovative architecture of the Flame Buildings, Fountain Square, and Heydar Aliyev Center. Then enjoy the Old City, a UNESCO World Heritage site, with Shirvan Shah's Palace and more. Night #2 in Baku.

Wednesday - 6/12/24 - Baku area, Azerbaijan

Travel south along the Caspian Sea to visit Qobustan National Park with 6,000 UNESCO World Heritage-listed petroglyphs. The prehistoric carvings, about 10,000 years old, depict scenes of hunting, fishing and gathering. At Qobustan Reserve see gurgling mud volcanoes; this region has about 400 mud volcanoes, more than half the world's total. Visit Ateshgah temple where Zoroastrians worshiped for over 2000 years. Continue to Yanar Dag Fire Mountain, a natural gas fire which burns continuously on a hillside. Night #3 in Baku.

Thursday – 6/13/24 - Baku – Sheki, Azerbaijan


Travel west from Baku through an arid landscape to end the day in the foothills of the forested Caucasus Mountains. En route visit Juma Mosque in Shemakha. Enjoy the picturesque mountain village of Lahic, with cobblestone streets and copper workshops. Continue to Sheki for one night at MinAli Boutique Hotel or equivalent.

Friday – 6/14/24 - Sheki, Azerbaijan to Telavi, Georgia

Wander around the lovely village of Sheki. Visit the beautifully renovated Sheki Khan's Palace, with magnificent frescoes and stained glass. Visit the local market and a handicrafts workshop. Depart Sheki and travel two hours to the border with Georgia. Cross the border and start exploring the beautiful landscape of vineyards and wine-producing villages of Georgia's Kakheti region. Tour and wine tasting at the unique Khareba wine cellar, located in a tunnel carved out

of the rock. Visit the photogenic fortified church complex of Gremi before reaching Telavi for one night at Chateau Mere or equivalent.

Saturday – 6/15/24 - Telavi – Tbilisi, Georgia

Visit Tsinandali, formerly a royal residence and now a museum with beautiful gardens. Continue to the 18th-century fortified hilltop town of Sighnaghi, one of the crossroads of the Silk Road and surrounded by defensive walls with 23 towers. Continue to Tbilisi for 2 nights at Riverside Hotel or equivalent.

<u>Sunday – 6/16/24 -Tbilisi, Georgia</u>



Spend the day touring Tbilisi, the pleasant capital city of Georgia. Visit churches, monuments, and take a cable car to Narikala fortress for a panoramic view of the city. Stroll through the old city, cross the innovatively designed Bridge of Peace, and visit the Open-Air Museum of Ethnography. In the evening, visit a local restaurant to enjoy delicious, traditional Georgian cuisine and enjoy a folklore show of traditional Georgian music and dance. Overnight in Tbilisi.


Monday – 6/17/24 - Tbilisi – Kazbegi, Georgia

Leave Tbilisi and travel to Mtskheta, Georgia's ancient capital and religious center (3000 years old) with two UNESCO World Heritage sites: Jvari church (6th century) and Svetitskhoveli Cathedral (11th century) where the crucifixion robe of Christ is said to be kept. Scenic drive through the Caucasus Mountains along the Georgian Military Highway. Stop at Ananuri, a 17th-century architectural complex of churches and towers, overlooking the Zhinvali reservoir. Reach Kazbegi, a small mountain town within view of glaciated Mt. Kazbek (16,500'). One night in Kazbegi at Rooms Hotel, with spectacular views of the mountains.

Tuesday - 6/18/24 - Kazbegi – Gori – Uplistsikhe - Tbilisi, Georgia

In the morning take an optional hike for about 2 hours through beautiful scenery to 14th-century Gergeti Trinity church, one of Georgia's most famous sites. In good weather there are outstanding views of Mt. Kazbek. Leave the mountains and visit the town of Gori, infamous as the birthplace of Josef Stalin. Visit the fascinating Stalin Museum with more than 60,000 artifacts, the tiny house where Stalin was born, and the bulletproof train Stalin used for travel. Next explore the ancient cave city of Uplistsikhe, an important religious center over 2,000 years ago. Return to Tbilisi, for one night at Riverside Hotel or equivalent.

Wednesday - 6/19/24 - Tbilisi, Georgia - Yerevan, Armenia

Cross border into Armenia. Visit 12th-century Haghartsin monastery in the Dilijan region, an area of forests and mountains. Continue to Lake Sevan, Armenia's first and foremost national park, with beautiful scenery and ancient monastic ruins at Sevanavank. Continue to Yerevan for 3 nights at Ramada Hotel or equivalent.

Thursday - 6/20/24 - Yerevan, Armenia

Visit Khor Virap monastery near the Turkish border, with amazing views of volcanic Mt. Ararat (legendary resting place of Noah's Ark). Continue to Noravank Monastery, wedged into a tall, red gorge. Visit a winery in Areni to sample wine from pomegranate and apricot. Night #2 in Yerevan.

Friday - 6/21/24 -Khor Virap – Areni – Norovank, Armenia

Marvel at Garni's magnificent pagan temple from the 1st-century. Visit Geghard monastery, partly carved into the side of the mountain and a UNESCO World Heritage site. Enjoy a city tour of Yerevan: visit the Cascade Monument, with great views of the city; Matenadaran, famous for being one of the world's best museums of medieval manuscripts with more than 60,000 documents. Visit the Armenian Genocide memorial, commemorating the victims of the first genocide of the 20th-century. In the evening, enjoy dinner and a show of traditional Armenian music and dance. Night #3 in Yerevan.




Saturday - 6/22/24 - Depart Armenia

OPTIONAL HIKING EXTENSION - CAUCASUS MTNS OF GEORGIA

JUNE 22–29, 2024 - \$1290 - includes private transport, local flights, 7 nights lodging, all breakfasts, 2 lunches, 2 dinners, entries/activities, Georgian hiking guide, Matt Ebiner as group leader. It might be possible to do ONLY this Georgia Hiking trip without the main tour; ask GeoTours if you're interested.

Saturday – 6/22/24 – Yerevan, Armenia to Kutaisi, Georgia

Fly Yerevan to Tbilisi (included in tour price). Transfer from TBS airport to Kutaisi, Georgia's 2nd largest city. Afternoon free to relax or explore. Two nights in Kutaisi.

Sunday – 6/23/24 – Kutaisi – Okatse Canyon – Prometheus Cave

Spend the day visiting natural wonders near Kutaisi. Hike 4 miles at Okatse Canyon through forest to a canyon with a remarkably

constructed metal walkway suspended along the side of the cliff. Visit Prometheus Cave, filled with stalactites and stalagmites, finishing with a short boat ride through the cave on a subterranean river. Night #2 in Kutaisi.

Monday – 6/24/24 – Tbilisi to Mestia (in the Caucasus Mtns of Georgia)

Travel from Kutaisi to Martvili Canyon for a 45-minute walk through lush forest and a 15-minute boat ride through the canyon. Drive 4 hours to Mestia in the Upper Svaneti region in the Caucasus Mountains. Upper Svaneti is a UNESCO World Heritage Site as an "exceptional example of mountain scenery with medieval-type villages and tower-houses", used for centuries to protect families from enemies. One night in Mestia at Hotel Elite House or similar.

Tuesday - 6/25/24 - Hiking in the Caucasus Mountains, Georgia

Hike 5 miles at elevations around 7,000' to Adishi village. It has a spectacular location amid snow-capped mountains and cascading streams, with ancient tower houses on grassy slopes. One night in Adishi at Panorama Guesthouse or similar.

Wednesday – 6/26/24 - Hiking in the Caucasus Mountains, Georgia

Magnificent hike from Adishi to Uprali (9 miles) in view of glaciers. It is usually possible to hire a horse if someone doesn't want to hike the entire route. Drive from Uprali to Ushguli, the "highest village in Europe" (about 7000'), in a beautiful location, with 20 ancient tower-houses. One night in Ushguli at Miranda Guesthouse or similar.

Thursday - 6/27/24 – Hiking in the Caucasus Mountains, Georgia

Day-hike or horse ride from Ushguli to Shkhara Glacier if the weather is good. Drive from Ushguli back to Mestia for one night at Hotel Elite House or similar.

Friday - 6/28/24 - Return to Tbilisi


If the weather is good, take a one-hour flight from Mestia to Tbilisi. Otherwise travel 8 hours by road from Mestia to Tbilisi. One night in Tbilisi.

Saturday – 6/29/24 – Depart Georgia

Depart Tbilisi to return to the USA (arrive home same day).

TOUR DATES & FLIGHTS

- Depart USA on 6/9/24 to GYD (Baku). Return from Yerevan (EVN) on 6/22/24
 - Or return home from Tbilisi (TBS) on 6/29/23 if doing the Georgia hiking extension
 - These flights will cost a total of ~\$1800, and Turkish Airlines is probably the best choice.
- GeoTours will provide information on recommended flights. Participants can travel on their own before or after the GeoTours trip, which will affect the dates and price of airline tickets.

TRANSPORTATION, PACE, WEATHER

- Private transportation throughout the trip, with a bus just for our group
- This trip has a moderate pace and participants should be able to walk up to 4 miles a day.
- Temperatures will range widely during the trip. The temperature in all these countries can reach 90-95F in the daytime. It is often cool at night and early morning, around 50-55F. On the Georgia hiking extension it will be cold at night (40-45F) and likely to rain at times. It rains in all these countries during June, so bring a compact umbrella.

CANCELLATION POLICY

To cancel your participation, you must inform GeoTours in writing or by email. Cancellation date is the date when GeoTours receives your written notice. *Cancellation penalty is the amount shown below PLUS any non-recoverable expenses already paid on behalf of the passenger, such as nonrefundable tickets or hotel rooms.
